An overview on progress of a Trust

After establishment in the year 2002, charitable activities for human welfare by The Gujarat Sarvajanik Welfare Trust, Ahmadabad are increasing by leaps and bounds. These activities taken up by the Trust are distributed under three fields like Education, Healthcare and Social upliftment.

Under Education, twelve schools at seven different places are managed as regular activity. Out of these, three schools are only for girls with medium of English and religions education as priority. Girls of these school are on the path of progress with CBSE syllabus. One of the three schools was awarded a British Award last year, a matter of pride. Besides, paramedical courses like physiotherapy, degree nursing and diploma nursing are also managed by the trust with sanction of 150 seats. Considering the economic condition of the students, 80 students are assisted financially waiving fees from 50% to 100%.

Besides, needy students including those of different Shama Schools are financially assisted with substantial amount. Efforts are made to update the knowledge of teachers of schools by arranging workshops from time to time. Similarly, efforts are made to counsel the students to brighten their future by arranging programmes for career guidance.

Under Healthcare, the trust provides health service with two hospitals. Dialysis is performed using 26 dialysis units in Shifa Dialysis Center. For all such treatments, provision of waiver of fee is made for poor patients.

Number of government and nongovernment schemes for upliftment of women are implemented by the women cell managed by the trust. The women cell is constantly striving to provide benefit of the government schemes to the beneficiaries.

Thus, the trust is performing its duty with innumerable activities. Obviously, significal financial support is is must to carry out human welfare activities free of charge. So far this task was accomplished by generous people like you. Same shall be completed even in future with such co operation. It is Allah who managed entire machinery with His will and also will manage. We are lucky for being selected for this act of charity.

I am grateful heartily to all those who are associated with this act of charity directly or indirectly. I also request my brothers -in – Islam to increase their contribution in this work of human welfare.
